**\$225 Basic Fee includes:** Pre-anesthesia testing/blood work, IV catheter, anesthesia, cleaning & polishing, C.E.T rinse, fecal, nail trim and pain medication. (1 night of hospitalization included if necessary for pet to stay depending on how the animal wakes from anesthesia.)

**Additional Costs NOT Included in Basic Fee & are NOT Discounted:**

- 1) **Any extraction(s)** will cost from \$25 - \$75; extraction pricing depends on the number and length of time it takes to remove. Most extractions cannot be detected until the animal is under anesthesia for a full dental exam.
- 2) **Antibiotics** will need to be started 2 days prior to the dental procedure.
- 3) **Other as needed:** IV fluids, vaccines, deworming, or unusual circumstances requiring additional medical attention.
